

## PATCHES AND VESTS

Thank you for the inquiry. Yes I make cub scout vests – using the same pattern style as the one at the Scout Store. I make them from Polyester cotton fabric for better wear (no pilling) and easy care (wash and drip dry –with the patches on this works best). The price is \$15.00.

I also sew scout patches to the vest or shirts. Simply place them in my porch box (plastic file type box) in a bag with your name and how best to reach you (phone /email) on it. You can simply drop a check (or cash in an envelope) with your items and I will call or email you when they are ready for pick up. I will place them back in the box and you can pick it up at your convenience.

Sewing prices are: \$1.00 per patch for the first 5 and 0.50 for each additional patch per sewing session.

From Bollinger Canyon head southbound on San Ramon Valley Blvd – go past Marie Callendar's and turn Right onto Barnwood

Into the Twin Creek Hills development. Turn Right onto Sombrero Circle
